

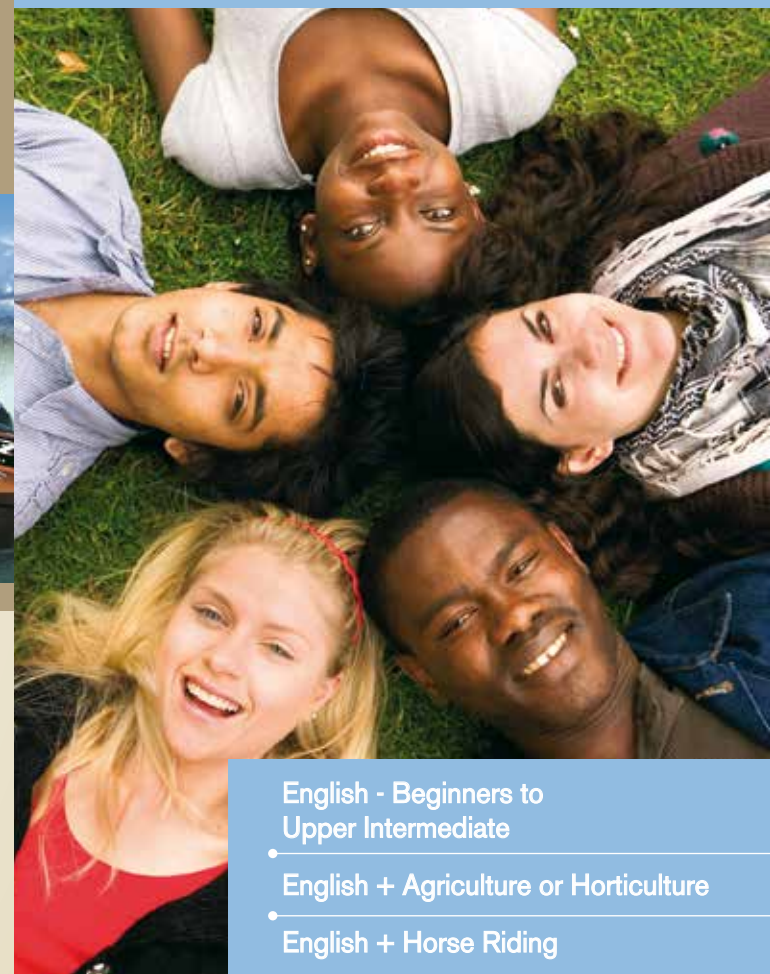

As many of our international students do not speak English as their first language we now provide English language courses for the benefit of current and future students.

COURSE OPTIONS



ENGLISH COURSES

1. General English Course (Beginners) – 12 weeks
2. General English Course (Elementary) – 12 weeks
3. General English Course (Pre-Intermediate) – 12 weeks
4. General English Course (Intermediate) – 12 weeks
5. General English Course (Upper Intermediate) – 12 weeks

Students will have the opportunity to develop English language skills at each level they enrol in, with a focus on the systems of English (grammar, vocabulary and pronunciation) and on the four language skills (listening, speaking, reading and writing). Emphasis will be on listening and speaking skills at each level.

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

Open to all international students who wish to develop their skills in English as a second language.

On completion of their studies, students can enrol in the next level course, depending on their visa.

The above courses are approved by the New Zealand Qualifications Authority under the provisions of the Education Act 1989 and the National Trade Academy is accredited to teach them.

English + Horse Riding – 4 week course minimum

Improve your English language skills and ride horses. You can learn or improve any of the following skills:

- Riding
- Horse care
- Feeding
- Dressage
- Show jumping
- Cross country riding

Our qualified riding instructors can teach you the basics or improve your riding skills if you are already experienced. Any level of riding ability is accepted.

Horse Treks are also available.

English + Agriculture

or Horticulture – 4 week course minimum

Improve your English language skills and learn New Zealand agriculture terminology and practical farming skills.

You can learn or improve any of the following skills:

- Ride an ATV (Quad Bike)
- Ride a motorbike
- Drive a tractor
- Fix fences
- Milking operations in a New Zealand Dairy Shed
- Propagation, soils and fertiliser use

If you have a farming background we can extend your knowledge to include stock handling, pasture management and animal feed and health management.
